Seventy-five years ago, Sir Alexander Fleming, Ernst Boris Chain, and Sir Howard Walter Florey were jointly awarded the 1945 Nobel Prize in Physiology or Medicine "for the discovery of penicillin and its curative effect in various infectious diseases." It was also during the 1940s that the drug was made available for therapeutic use. Rapid advances were made in understanding the molecular structure of the antibiotic, as well as higher-volume, more cost-effective manufacturing processes. Today, penicillin is still one of the most widely used antibiotic agents in the world. Like all its therapeutic relatives, penicillin is regulated and must be produced according to good manufacturing practices. SQA visits thousands of suppliers all over the world and evaluates their manufacturing practices against industry standards – thereby helping clients, and ultimately patients, assure quality in their antibiotic supply.

Fifty years ago, the first deliveries and commercial flights of the new Boeing 747 Jumbo Jet took place and changed the face of aviation for the decades to follow. Overcoming predictions of a future with other sleeker, supersonic aircraft and a lost opportunity for a military transport contract, the design and production team at Boeing – who became known as "The Incredibles" – bounced back to roll out the largest civilian airplane in the world in a record 16 months. The iconic Queen of the Skies made its mark with a design that moved the cockpit up and out of the way of main-deck loading and created space for what was to become a symbol of 1970s style: the first-class, upper-deck lounge. Numerous variations followed, and in 2014, the Boeing 747 became the first wide-body commercial/cargo aircraft in history to reach 1,500 deliveries. According to the Ninth Annual Cost of Cybercrime Study published by Accenture, security breaches have increased 67% in the past five years, and the organizational value that is at risk globally from direct and indirect cyberattacks over the next five years is \$5.2 trillion. Quality and risk management go hand-in-hand, and the mechanisms set up to identify and mitigate risks in the supply chain naturally extend to the realm of cybersecurity. To this end, supplier quality assurance initiatives are being broadened to ensure that preventative measures that are applied internally are applied in equal measure upstream in the supply chain. According to defense security experts, second- and third-tier suppliers become the next logical target for major manufacturers with effective security systems in place. SQA's major audit programs have steadily evolved to incorporate the increasing demands of data integrity and security in the supply chain - even to the extent that cybersecurity-only supplier audit programs are now a reality.

While it has been more than 90 years since the famous Hollywood stunt pilot, Roscoe Turner, managed to safely recover a whole aircraft using a specially configured parachute, full aircraft recovery did not begin to take serious shape until the 1980s, with a ballistic recovery system patent filed by Boris Popov following his near-death experience in a hang glider. The concept of aircraft recovery was further developed after Alan Klapmeier, the co-founder of Cirrus Aircraft with his brother Dale, also survived a serious light aircraft accident, and as a result, decided to implement a survival device on the company's aircraft models. A collaboration in 1998 between Popov's company, Ballistic Recovery Systems, and the Klapmeier brothers, saw the concept widely realized, leading to many hundreds of lives saved in the years since. Today, the whole-airframe parachute comes standard on several models of aircraft, including jet-powered models. SQA's long association with the aviation industry – notably our chairman, Jim McKay's, and Jim's grandson, Johnny McKay's, personal stakes as certified pilots – has made our contributions in aviation supplier quality assurance understandably personal.

Fifty-six years after Tokyo first hosted the Summer Olympic Games, the city will once again be home to the Olympic flame. More than 11,000 athletes and 206 nations are expected to participate, and the city is planning for almost one million visitors per day. The Organizing Committee is well placed to take advantage of the many modern quality management tools and techniques originating in Japan to prepare, execute, and control the countless tasks involved with planning the Olympic Games. In addition, to maximize the budget of nearly US\$13 billion announced by the Organizing Committee in December 2018, Tokyo will use as many existing competition venues as possible – specifically, those built for the Games in 1964. This is aligned with five main sustainability themes: Climate Change (zero carbon); Resource Management (zero waste); Natural Environment and Biodiversity; Human Rights, Labor, and Fair Business Practices; and Involvement, Cooperation, and Communications (engagement). According to the International Olympic Committee, "The goal of the Olympic Movement is to contribute to building a peaceful and better world by educating youth through sport practiced without discrimination of any kind and in the Olympic spirit, which requires mutual understanding with a spirit of friendship, solidarity and fair play." SQA enthusiastically supports this goal and looks forward to enjoying the Games.

Almost a quarter-century ago, companies were proposing conceptual designs for a "affordable next generation strike aircraft weapon systems for the Navy, Air Force, Marines, and allies" Joint Strike Fighter aircraft. To achieve this, the final product would have to incorporate advanced stealth, exceptional agility and maneuverability, sensor and information fusion, network-enabled operations, and advanced sustainment. The result was the F-35 Lightning II, an aircraft that boasts greater survivability, situational awareness, and effectiveness for pilots, as well as improved readiness and lower support costs. The system is available in several configurations and is just as impressive in "Stealth Mode" as it is in "Beast Mode." A network of more than 1,500 suppliers produces the nearly 300,000 parts, with approximately 11,000 unique part numbers, used to build each F-35. The production process of the F-35 has steadily evolved since it was first delivered in 2011. At that time, it took 153,000 hours to build. In 2015, deliveries were meeting the 50,000-hour mark. Today, the focus continues to be on efficiency and quality improvement. With a proud history of support of the defense industry, SQA is excited to see quality playing a role in protecting peacekeepers around the world with such cutting-edge defense initiatives.

Quality is Monumental

Set in the granite batholith of the Black Hills of South Dakota, Mount Rushmore stands 500 feet high as a symbol of the passion and proactive persistence that the founders and Presidents of the United States of America embodied to unite the nation. In 1923, South Dakota state historian Doane Robinson had an idea to carve a monument to pay homage to the leaders who have played important roles in American history, and in 1924, he convinced sculpture artist, Gutzon Borglum, to design and construct the sculpture. Charles E. Rushmore, a title attorney and the namesake for the land where the monument sits, was a proud donor in support of Borglum's vision for "a national monument commemorating America's founders and builders." The Presidential monument, which was built by more than 400 workers, and took nearly a quarter of a century to complete, represents the first 130 years of US history. Presidents Washington, Lincoln, Jefferson, and Roosevelt were selected by Borglum because of their role in preserving the Republic and their ability to best exemplify the foundation, expansion, and perseverance that he felt Americans should not take for granted. Often focused on the daily grind, Americans rarely take the time to consider the founders and Presidents of the United States of America and the example they have set for grand pursuits and perseverance.
