The human eye is made up of more than two million working parts and contains 107 million light-sensitive cells that can differentiate approximately 10 million colors. It is no wonder that visual inspection has always been a key component of the quality process. SQA's source inspection programs use advanced visual and other techniques to support quality-critical manufacturing all over the world. Every year, SQA's inspection team validates more than one million parts prior to release. We are often on the production floor working in conjunction with automated equipment. Automation maximizes speed and minimizes manual limitations, but it is often visual interpretation that catches subtle cosmetic functional flaws and variations. With SQA inspection teams using our tablet-based inspection application, we have learned that the combination of human visual inspection with the speed and robustness of an automated system provides the best overall results for quality.

2022 marks the 100th anniversary of insulin being used to treat diabetes. According to the World Health Organization, in 2019, over 1.5 million people died from diabetes worldwide. However, over 450 million diabetics are treated. In 1922, researchers Frederick Banting, John Macleod, George Best, and Bertram Collip isolated the hormone insulin and purified it so it could be administered to humans in the treatment of diabetes. To balance a patient's sugar levels, insulin can be given via syringes or pumps – some of which are evolving into extraordinarily advanced Class II and III medical devices. Today, SQA supports the world's largest insulin and insulin pump manufacturers by integrating with their quality teams, monitoring, and assessing products to ensure patients are treated safely.

Quality is Legendary

Few people are as deserving of the term "legend" as Duke Paoa Kahinu Mokoe Hulikohola Kahanamoku. Duke, whose name was inherited from his father, was a native Hawaiian born in 1890. An incredible athlete, he was a five-time Olympic medalist in swimming, pioneered early surfboard designs, and was largely responsible for introducing surfing to various continents around the world. In addition, he was a sheriff, actor, and businessman – all after leaving school early to support his family. On June 14, 1925, Duke rescued eight passengers from a capsized boat in dangerous seas using only his surfboard. The Newport Beach Police chief called his efforts "the most superhuman rescue act and the finest display of surfboard riding that has ever been seen in the world." This led to lifeguards using surfboards as standard equipment for water rescues. His colorful life led him to exploits such as teaching the hula to Queen Elizabeth and showing FDR's family how to paddle an outrigger. Today, his statue stands tall on Waikiki Beach, inspiring visitors from all around the world to never stop improving and to never stop aiming for greater achievements, a goal to which SQA Services can certainly relate!
